WE ARE PETER, MOLLY, AND LEAH

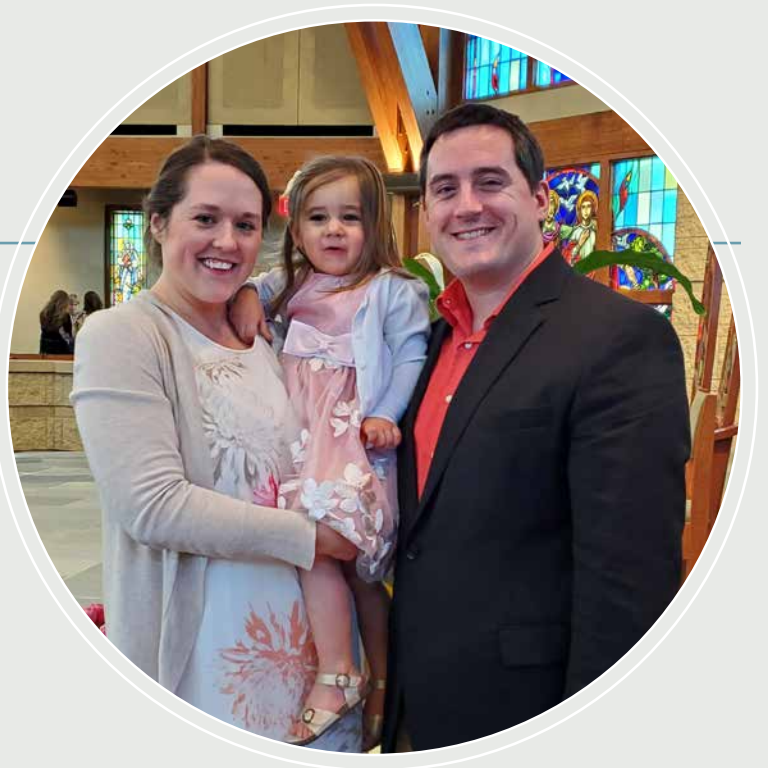

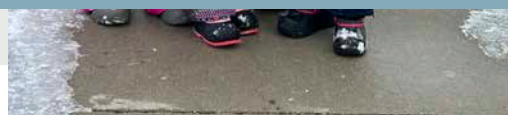
ABOUT US

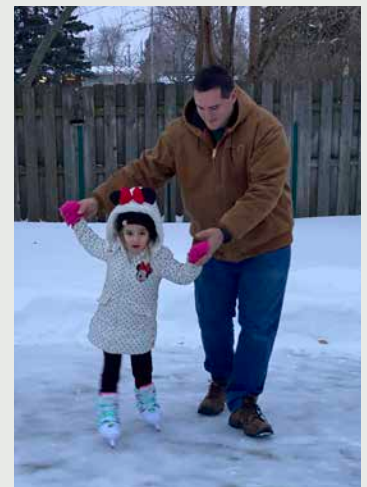

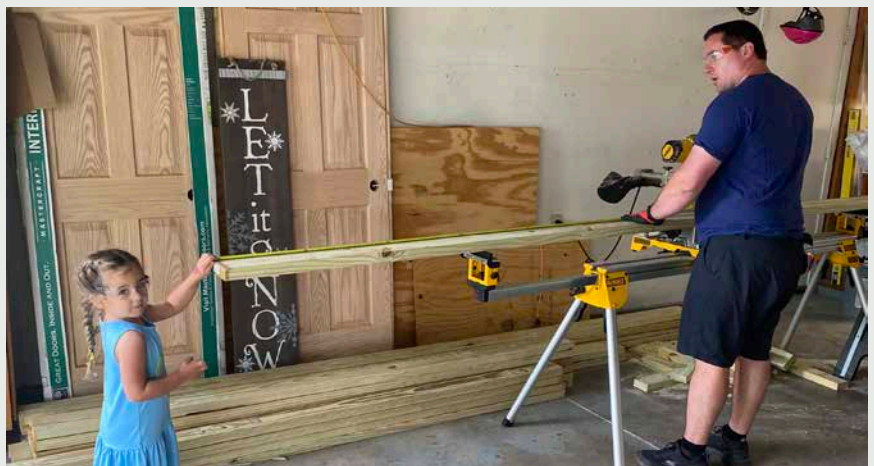
HARDWORKING
